

INTRODUCTION

The Rolls-Royce Enthusiasts' Club (RREC) caters for anyone with an interest in the motor car products of Rolls-Royce, including Bentley cars built from 1933 onwards. From just 11 people at the inaugural meeting in 1957, membership now stands at 10,000 and the Club celebrated its fiftieth anniversary in style in 2007. Membership is open to owners and non-owners alike and members are drawn from all walks of life and from most countries of the world. With a justifiable reputation for friendliness and informality, membership of the RREC enables like-minded enthusiasts to meet and share experiences, advice and the enjoyment of some of the finest vehicles in the world.

To this end, there are forty regional Sections, UK and Overseas, and eight Registers, catering for specific groups of models from Silver Ghost to Silver Shadow. Each member receives a fully illustrated bi-monthly 68-page 'Bulletin' magazine covering historical and technical articles, as well as all aspects of the Club's activities, together with the monthly 'Advertiser' which offers a fine cross-section of cars for sale. There is also a wealth of informative material to be found on the "members only" area of our website, which incorporates a members' discussion forum.

The Club enjoys a formal license from Rolls-Royce plc and also benefits from recognition by, and a close working relationship with, Rolls-Royce Motor Cars Limited and Bentley Motors Limited.

HEADQUARTERS

Widely regarded as the largest and most comprehensive of any single marque car club in the world, the Club's permanent headquarters are established at the Sir Henry Royce Memorial Foundation building, known as The Hunt House, in the village of Paulerspury in Northamptonshire. As well as administrative offices manned by a full-time permanent staff, the complex also houses workshops, a classroom and the Club Shop.

The Club Shop has a wide range of goods for sale exclusively to Club members. These goods include technical works, Rolls-Royce and Bentley books, Club regalia and personal and car accessories, all of which are available for purchase either over the counter, on line via our website, or by telephone.



EVENTS

Throughout the year all over the world numerous tours, rallies, weekend and social events are enjoyed by RREC members. These may be organised by the Sections or the Registers, or be national events organised centrally.

For many members, the highlight of the year is the Annual Rally and Concours. This is the largest Rolls-Royce and Bentley gathering anywhere in the world and makes a spectacular sight. The whole event spans a weekend, with trade and other stands, an auction of cars and automobilia, as well as class judging and a parade of prize winning cars.

For the first time in 2007, the Club staged an extremely successful stand at the NEC Classic Car Show in Birmingham, winning the Best Stand in Show award for a Club with more than 5000 members.

TECHNICAL

The Club offers extensive technical services. These include the provision of monthly Technical Seminars in the Club's fully equipped workshops, technical information, owners' handbooks, catalogues of parts, workshop manuals, data sheets and scores of special and general arrangement drawings. Technical advice and expertise is also available through the specific model Registers. Additionally, there is a specialist Tool Hire service exclusively for members.

A fully illustrated colour bi-monthly A4 'Bulletin' magazine is distributed to all members. The Bulletin runs to sixty-eight pages per issue and covers all aspects of the Club's activities, including regular features on historical, technical and social subjects.
